OPENING

- 1. <u>Roll Call</u>. Acting Village Clerk Stratton conducted roll call of the Village Board of Trustees with all members present except Trustee Long. President Clatfelter noted Trustee Long had and excused absence. President Clatfelter indicated that there was a quorum present to conduct Village business.
