New Waldrop Park softball field underway

SAS and the Village of Sherman were delighted to break ground on the fourth softball field earlier this spring. The large new field, currently in Phase I of construction, is part of the master plan to improve facilities at Waldrop Park.

Funded by team fundraising, SAS leadership and the Village of Sherman, the improvements will include fencing, more parking, new bleachers, dugout shelters, a scoreboard, and more.

UPDATE: Construction Begins Soon!

Once completed, hundreds of residents living north of the park on that road will have a safe route. The Village secured funding for the project through a state DCEO grant.

Village Projects Not Spared By Rising Building Costs

The post-pandemic building boon has hit Sherman the same as every other community. Construction costs are high right now, too high to responsibly go forward immediately with some long-planned projects.

We are still strongly committed to these projects, just like we are committed to telling you the hard truth, every time. So, here is where we are:



Splash Pad

We went to bid on this project earlier this year but the cost associated with construction – materials and labor - was greater than anticipated on those bids. We are exploring rebidding the project, this time separating the project from other park projects (i.e. perimeter fencing) to get more bidders and, hopefully, lower priced bids. The goal is to complete the Splash Pad by Summer 2023.

Fitness Stations

We continue to evaluate the purchase of the fitness stations to be installed along the walking/biking path in Village Park based on current construction costs. We are still strongly committed to the project but the price will determine how quickly we can make this a reality. We will keep you posted.



Dedication of Village Park Playground

On June 11, Village leaders dedicated new signage that honors all of the extraordinary volunteers from a few area union locals who installed the equipment and innovative ground cover at our Village Park playground at no cost to the Village.

SHERMAN LIMB PICK-UP SCHEDULE

APRIL THROUGH OCTOBER 2022

1st and 3rd Tuesdays

All neighborhoods and subdivisions on the **WEST** side of Business 55 (Sherman Boulevard): Flaggland Park, North Haven, Red Bud Run, The Rail, Rail Estates, Sebring Road, Old Tipton Estates, Lyndale, Crown Pointe, Parkway and Amherst Drives, Britton Place, Waterford.

2nd and 4th Tuesdays

All neighborhoods and subdivisions on the **EAST** side of Business 55 (Sherman Boulevard): Original Sherman, Quail Ridge, Birch Lakes, Steeplechase, Brookside Glen, Prairie at Brookside Glen, Spring Lake Estates, Golden Pond, Brierwood, Timberline Estates, Prairie Lake Estates, Georgetown Oaks.

- Place limbs at curbside by 6:00am on your scheduled pick-up day.
- Entire trees are **NOT** accepted, this requires the services of professional tree removers.
- Limit the amount of limbs to no more than a small truck load.
- Limit the size of limbs to no longer than 8 ft. in length.
- Limbs trimmed by professional tree services will **NOT** be picked up.
- The Village will **NOT** accept grass clippings, leaves, weeds, etc.
- Limb pick-up will **NOT** take place on a 5th Tuesday.
- Entire trees will **NOT** be picked up due to storm damage. This requires the service of professional tree removers.

If your pile contains brush, plant material or related landscape material it may not be picked up. Check out the Village Burn Schedule at www.shermanil.org

Attention, Residents with Grinder Pumps

A reminder for those homes in the Village with Grinder Pump Sewer Service – let’s work together to keep those systems functioning. The following is a list of the types of waste products that create maintenance issues:

- Grease from cooked food
- Female sanitary products
- Diapers, baby wipes, etc.
- Floor cleaning pads
- Rags
- Small solid objects
- Paper towels
- Towelettes (including those marked “flushable”)
- Kitty Litter
- Socks, undergarments or any articles of clothing

There is one pump for every two houses on most accounts and when one homeowner triggers a service call, both homes are affected and both parties may receive a bill for reimbursement if the service is required due to prohibited waste. Also, during power failures, avoid water usage as much as possible.
