CERTIFICATIONS BY APPLICANT

In conjunction with Application for Liquor License, the undersigned Applicant hereby certifies as follows:

1. Applicant is of good character and reputation in the community in which he/she resides.
2. Applicant is a citizen of the United States.
3. Applicant has not been convicted of a felony under the laws of any State.
4. Applicant has not been convicted of being a keeper or is keeping a house of ill fame.
5. Applicant has not been convicted of pandering or other crimes of misdemeanor opposed to decency and morality.
6. Applicant has not had a license, issued under this Chapter, revoked for cause or a liquor license issued under State law or other municipal ordinance revoked for cause.
7. Applicant, if co-partnership or corporation, knows of no reason why all such partners or corporate officers, directors, or stockholders, would not be eligible for such license.
8. Applicant has not been convicted of a violation of any federal or state law concerning the manufacture, possession, or sale of alcoholic liquor, or has forfeited his bond to appear in court to answer charges for any such violation.
9. Applicant is the beneficial owner or lessee of the premises for the full period for which the license is to be issued.
10. Applicant is not a law enforcing public official, Village President, or any member of the Village Board of Trustees or employee of the Village.
11. Applicant is eligible for State Retail Liquor Dealer License.
12. Applicant has not been convicted of a gambling offense.
13. Applicant does not have a federal gaming device stamp or a federal wagering stamp issued by the federal government for the current tax period.
14. Applicant is not indebted to the Village or other governmental entity for payment of any other fees, charges, bills, or taxes which he is obligated to pay but have remained unpaid for more than 45 days.
15. Applicant has evidenced insurance coverage for dram shop liability as required by this Chapter.

16. Applicant's place of business is not within 100 feet of any church or school.
17. Applicant will not violate any of the laws of the state or of the United States or any ordinances of the Village in the conduct of his or her place of business.
18. Applicant has certifications from the appropriate county health department and the Village building and zoning department indicated that the proposed licensed premises comply with the regulations and ordinances of the departments.
19. APPLICANT FURTHER EXPRESSLY REPRESENTS that neither the applicant, if an individual, nor any member of the co-partnership, if applicant, is a co-partner, nor any manager or agent or applicant, in case the place of business is conducted by such manager or agent, nor, in case of a corporation, any officer, manager, or director thereof, or any stockholder thereof, owning in the aggregate more than five percent (5%) of the stock of such corporation, if any, has ever been convicted of a felony under the laws of the State of Illinois, or any State of the United States, is the keeper or has ever been convicted of being a keeper of a house of ill fame, has ever been convicted of pandering or other crime or misdemeanor opposed to decency and morality, has ever had a license issued under the ordinances of said Village or under "An Act Relating to Alcoholic Liquors", approved January 31, 1934, as amended, revoked for cause, has ever been convicted of a violation of any Federal or State law concerning the manufacture, possession, or sale of alcoholic liquors, subsequent to the passage of said Act, has ever forfeited any bond to appear in court to answer charges for any such violation, or is a law enforcing public official, mayor, alderman, member of any Village Board of Trustees, or a President or member of any County Board of Trustees, or a President or member of any County Board, or is disqualified to receive a license by reason of any matter or thing contained in the laws of this State or any of the ordinances of said Village.

CLASSES OF LIQUOR LICENSES AND LICENSE FEES

CLASS	DESCRIPTION	FEE
Class A	A Class "A" License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption only on the premises where sold. The service of food may be incidental to the license and not more than 30% of the retail sales of the establishment.	\$300.00 per year
Class A-1	A Class "A-1" License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the premises where sold as well beer in its original package and not for consumption on the premises where sold, which premises shall not be located on property or in a building that is used, in whole or in part, for residential purposes. The service of food may be incidental to the license and not more than 30% of the retail sales of the establishment.	\$300.00 per year
Class B	A Class "B" License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor only in original packages and not for consumption on the premises where sold, which premises shall not be located on property or in a building that is used, in whole or in part, for residential purposes.	\$300.00 per year
Class C	A Class "C" License shall be issued only to restaurants engaged primarily in selling and serving meals and which shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquors on the premises as incidental thereto. The sale and service of alcoholic liquor must be served at tables where meals are served, or at a bar or counter, provided that the percentage of sales related to alcoholic liquors cannot exceed 30% of the total retail sales of the restaurant; and (2) any bar area must be specifically identified as such in the license.	\$300.00 per year
Class D	Class "D" License. A Class "D" License shall only be issued for special public or private events sponsored by civic, fraternal, political subdivisions or religious organizations and shall authorize the retail sale, consumption, gift, or dispensing on the premises specified of alcoholic beverages.	\$300.00 per year*
Class F	Class "F" License. A Class "F" License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor for consumption on the licensed premises only in connection with scheduled special functions such as banquets, wedding receptions, and other private party functions where meals are served and where the service of alcoholic beverages is primarily incidental and complementary to the service of such meals. No retail sale of alcoholic liquor shall be made at any time to the general public (other than to those in attendance at the banquets, wedding receptions, or other party functions). This license shall not be issued for more than eight (8) hours.	\$50.00 per event
Class VG	Class "VG" License. A Class "VG" License shall be a supplemental license that may be issued only to holders of a Class "A", Class "A-1" or Class "C" License. Holders of a Class "VG" License may conduct video gaming on the premises where licensed, in addition to the service of alcohol, upon issuance of a video gaming license from the Illinois Gaming Board and in compliance with the Video Gaming Act and any and all other rules and regulations, including all ordinances enacted by the Village. Prior to the issuance of a Class VG License, an application must be filled with the Liquor Control Commissioner seeking the license, setting forth that any and all legal requirements to hold the license are met and the proposed use of video gaming within the licensed establishment, which may be contingent on the issuance of a license from the Illinois Gaming Board and an establishment permit by the Village. The Village reserves the right to revoke a license if video gaming is not active on the premises within 60 days of the application and/or video gaming otherwise ceases on the premises for a period of 30 consecutive days. The application procedures set forth elsewhere within this Chapter shall be applicable to the issuance of a Class "VG" License.	\$500.00 per year
