- 1. Applicant is of good character and reputation in the community in which he/she resides.
- 2. Applicant is a citizen of the United States.
- 3. Applicant has not been convicted of a felony under the laws of any State.
- 4. Applicant has not been convicted of being a keeper or is keeping a house of ill fame.
- 5. Applicant has not been convicted of pandering or other crimes of misdemeanor opposed to decency and morality.
- 6. Applicant has not had a license, issued under this Chapter, revoked for cause or a liquor license issued under State law or other municipal ordinance revoked for cause.
- 7. Applicant, if co-partnership or corporation, knows of no reason why all such partners or corporate officers, directors, or stockholders, would not be eligible for such license.
- 8. Applicant has not been convicted of a violation of any federal or state law concerning the manufacture, possession, or sale of alcoholic liquor, or has forfeited his bond to appear in court to answer charges for any such violation.
- 9. Applicant is the beneficial owner or lessee of the premises for the full period for which the license is to be issued.
- 10. Applicant is not a law enforcing public official, Village President, or any member of the Village Board of Trustees or employee of the Village.
- 11. Applicant is eligible for State Retail Liquor Dealer License.
- 12. Applicant has not been convicted of a gambling offense.
- 13. Applicant does not have a federal gaming device stamp or a federal wagering stamp issued by the federal government for the current tax period.
- 14. Applicant is not indebted to the Village or other governmental entity for payment of any other fees, charges, bills, or taxes which he is obligated to pay but have remained unpaid for more than 45 days.
- 15. Applicant has evidenced insurance coverage for dram shop liability as required by this Chapter.

- 16. Applicant's place of business is not within 100 feet of any church or school.
- 17. Applicant will not violate any of the laws of the state or of the United States or any ordinances of the Village in the conduct of his or her place of business.
